

Minuet in A minor

Johann Sebastian Bach

BWV Anh. 120

The first system of the Minuet in A minor, measures 1-7. The music is in 3/4 time and A minor. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the left hand provides a steady accompaniment of eighth notes.

The second system of the Minuet in A minor, measures 8-14. It begins with a repeat sign at measure 8. The right hand continues its melodic development, and the left hand maintains the accompaniment. A repeat sign is also present at the end of the system.

The third system of the Minuet in A minor, measures 15-21. This system includes trills (tr.) in both the right and left hands. The right hand has a trill on the final note of the system, and the left hand has trills on several notes.

The fourth system of the Minuet in A minor, measures 22-28. This system also features trills (tr.) in both hands. The right hand has a trill on the final note, and the left hand has trills on several notes. The piece concludes with a repeat sign and a fermata over the final note.
